KNOW YOUR TOOLS

WHAT'S BEST TO USE?

- Scissors, razor, or clippers?
- There's no definitive set of circumstances where you would decide to use one over the other.
 - It depends on the look and the mood of the haircut you are looking to create.

WHY SCISSORS?


- Clean lines, blunt lines, detailing.
- The tool we are most familiar with.
- Scissors are a fundamental tool we all have in our kit.
- Versatile tool. Allows for multiple techniques, resulting in a blunt and precise finish.

WHY RAZOR?

- Perfectly imperfect shapes.
- Adds soft and flowy movement with choppy yet soft edges.
- Helps remove bulk for haircuts that hug the head shape.

WHY CLIPPERS?

- Precise and consistent cuts with different lengths.
- Faster and more efficient compared to scissors.
- Ideal for creating fades and designs.

- Diffuser
- Curling iron
- Microfiber towel
- Flat clips

TEXTURED SHULLET

STEP ONE

PREP HAIR.

- Use **I WANT MOISTURE SHAMPOO & CONDITIONER.**
- Mist with **TRI-WHEAT LEAVE-IN CONDITIONER** for the optimum cutting experience.

STEP TWO

SECTION OUT THE FRINGE.

- Create an arched fringe from high recession to the opposite side approximately 3/4-1 inch deep.
- Section the top from recession to recession following the parietal ridge to the mid-crown.

STEP THREE

CUT THE FRINGE.

- Section out and cut a short blunt fringe.

STEP FOUR

CUT THE TOP.

- Take 1" horizontal sections through the top profile, divide into 5 vertical subsections.
- Using the fringe length as a guide, cut up and out from 90°-0° finishing slightly longer than the fringe.
- In the remaining top sections, increase elevation and length in each subsection by using your guide from the previously cut section.

STEP FIVE

CUT THE SIDES.

- In side profiles, create vertical subsections.
- Starting next to face, direct the section towards face and connect by cutting down and increasing length slightly as you move to the bottom.
- Repeat in each vertical subsection, directing to the same guide towards the face, incorporating the length from the top to create continuity.

STEP SIX

CUT THE BACK.

Divide back into 4 vertical subsections, each section is directed forward like the sides and cut along the same guide.

STEP SEVEN

CHECK BALANCE.

- Divide front from back and left from right, and again divide each section in half, creating 8 radial subsections.
- Elevate each subsection to 90° to check for balance and connection. Connect if necessary.



TEXTURED SHULLET

TEXTURED STYLING

STEP ONE

- Re-saturate the hair with water and **TRI-WHEAT LEAVE-IN CONDITIONER**, starting in the nape apply **ULTRA CURL** to small sections twisting as you go, scrunch with microfiber towel.
- Repeat, moving up the head shape.
- From the mid-occipital up add **ROOT PUMP PLUS** before applying **ULTRA CURL** while twisting and establishing a wet curl set.

STEP TWO

- In the fringe section, pin curls delicately back, dry the micro fringe with a Denman brush to create a sleek finish.
- For added volume or added curl, use pin curl clips to prop the curl at the base and shape and secure the curl as you are to form the curls on top of the fringe.
- Re-wet the curls if they're drying without forming — the wetter they are, the better your curl formation will be.
- You will be directing all the hair on top and in front of the ears forward and keeping the back where it lives naturally.

STEP THREE

- Use flat clips to divide the front from back, from just behind the ears to high point of head to opposite side.
- Lean the head forward, starting in the front top, diffuse on low heat and low speed.
- Continue to diffuse the entire head moving slowly and patiently until the hair is completely dry.

STEP FOUR

Apply **PROTECT ME** and use appropriately sized curling iron to polish a few curls if necessary, try to keep the curls in their natural diffused state.

STEP FIVE

Apply **POWDER PLAY LITE** to the top and sides at the root area, diffuse into the hair for natural fluffy volume.

STEP SIX

Optional: Finish with **STYLING PASTE** on the ends to polish and keep in place.

SMOOTH-ISH STYLING (ALTERNATE FINISH)

STEP ONE

- On damp hair, apply **ROOT PUMP PLUS** to the root area and **HIGH STANDARDS** to the mid lengths and ends.
- Direct all the hair on top and in front of the ears forward and keep the back where it lives naturally.

STEP TWO


- Diffuse the hair (medium heat & speed) with your hands directing and volumizing the hair where needed to create a polished yet lived-in style.
- Polish and/or direct the hair with a flat iron if necessary, but focus on leaving plenty of natural texture and movement.

STEP THREE

Use **STYLING PASTE** to detail the ends and finish with **WEATHER PROOF**.

STEP ONE

SECTION OUT THE FRINGE

- Section the top from recession to recession following the parietal ridge to the mid-crown.
- Section out the nape area and create two small sections with the remaining hair.
- Section out the sides from just behind the ear.

STEP TWO

ESTABLISH PERIMETER

- Determine desired perimeter length.
- In the back profile, subdivide into vertical partings. Low elevation, 45° finger angle.
- Etch to perimeter with razor, removing corners.

STEP THREE

SIDE PROFILES

- Subdivide into vertical sections.
- Repeat angles and elevation from back.
- Section near back of ear: direct slightly to nape. All other sections: cut where they live.

STEP FOUR

FRINGE

- Divide fringe horizontally in half; clip top away.
- Bottom half: create 3 vertical subsections.
- Center subsection: comb flat, twist L-R and R-L, etch with razor.
- Side fringe sections: bring to opposite side, low elevation, cut shorter-to-longer.
- Drop top section: subdivide vertically, elevate to 135°, cut using guide underneath.

STEP FIVE

INTERIOR LAYERS (CENTER BACK)

- Vertical sections, 90° elevation, 90° finger angle.
- Cut short-to-long with razor, using guide underneath.
- Ear-adjacent corners: direct straight back to nape.
- Add in sides if needed.

STEP SIX

CROWN & RADIALS

- Drop crown section.
- From crown center: create radial partings.
- Over-direct each section opposite where it lives, 90° elevation.
- Etch short-to-long with razor.

STEP SEVEN

DETAIL & FINISH

- Personalize texture.
- Balance weight and perimeter.



FLUTTER BOB

TEXTURED ROUND BRUSH FINISH

- Apply **TEXTURE SEXYHAIR FOAM PARTY** from roots to ends.
- Flat-wrap blow dry until 75% dry.
- Using vertical sections, round brush horizontally, then twist to vertical as you reach the ends.
- Continue this method through entire head shape.
- In fringe area: Round brush under, on base, for smooth lift.
- Apply **TEXTURE SEXYHAIR SURFER GIRL** and shape to desired result.

WET-LOOK TWIST CURLS

- Apply **PROTECT ME**.
- Using a ½-inch curling iron, create twist curls with vertical sections.
- Apply **PLAY DIRTY** to shape and define curls for a wet-look finish.
- Apply **POLISHED UP** for sleek, lived-in texture.
